Adult Respite Care

A social respite program is offered in Harleyville on Wednesdays at The First Baptist Church to give family caregivers a needed break from the stress of around-the-clock caregiving. Respite programs keep loved ones with memory loss connected to their community through fellowship and fun. Loving Hearts Respite Center serves the surrounding communities and is sponsored by The ARK of SC as an outreach of the NOAH Project (Neighborhood Outreach Alzheimer's Help).

Support Group

A dementia support group meets on the 2nd Monday of the month at the First Baptist Church in Harleyville. This group meets in a therapeutic environment to help caregivers learn coping skills through sharing with each other and with guest speakers.

Community Learning Programs

Loving Hearts Respite Center partners with The ARK of SC and other community resources to offer a variety of educational opportunities related to caregiving and dementia throughout the year.
